CANVAS

Canvas is a user-friendly, web-based Learning Management System that will be your gateway to all course activities and materials. Canvas can be accessed using a common web browser.

TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

To participate effectively in courses at Seton Montessori Institute, you will need some basic personal computing skills and the hardware and software listed below. If computer use is new to you, we strongly recommend enrolling in a computer skills class at your local library, community center or college prior to beginning the course.

COMPUTER ACCESS

You will need access to a computer or tablet with connected internet access for 10 or more hours per week. You can log in to Canvas anytime and anywhere from any computer with a wifi connection.

INTERNET CONNECTION REQUIREMENTS

High-speed internet access is required. Most any of the more current connectivity options (DSL, cable, fiber, etc.) should work well.

RECOMMENDED HARDWARE REQUIREMENTS

- A personal computer (PC or Mac) that is no more than five years old; or a current tablet (e.g., Surface or iPad). We do not recommend purchasing a Chromebook.
- 2 GB of RAM (or higher)
- Monitor with screen resolution of 1024 x 768 (or higher)
- Printer

SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

- Word processing: Microsoft Word or similar program that produces .doc or .docx files
- Web browser: The latest versions of Chrome, Firefox or Safari work well.
- Browser plug-ins: These common, free downloads add functions you'll need on your browser (may already be installed)
 - Acrobat Reader for opening and reading .pdf (Portable Document Format) files
 - QuickTime for playing audio and video excerpts

OTHER TIPS

- Google Chrome browser benefits ELL students as it has built-in translation software.
- When submitting assignments, they must be formatted as a .doc, .docx, .gdoc or .pdf format.
